REVISIT: Plural Possession

These resources can be used at any point during the teaching sequence on possessive apostrophes to show plural possession. The games are perfect to use as a starter activity to revisit previous learning or as an intervention for pupils who may need to practise and consolidate their knowledge further in an adult guided group.

Game 1 plural possession	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Choose a plural noun card. 2. Discuss what could belong to the plural noun and how we could show plural possession using the word. 3. Write the phrase or sentence, punctuating it correctly using an apostrophe to show plural possession. <p>➤ Blank copies of the cards are included for pupils or adults to add further nouns.</p>	
Game 2 singular or plural possession	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Choose a phrase card and read the information. 2. Discuss the possession (who owns what) and whether it is showing singular or plural possession, and sort it using the heading cards. 3. Orally compose a sentence that includes the phrase showing possession. 4. Write the phrase or sentence, punctuating it correctly. <p>➤ Blank copies of the cards are included for pupils or adults to add further phrases.</p>
