# Year 2: Term 3 – Caring for Others

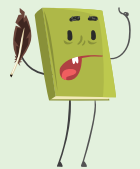
## Unit overview and guidance

Introduce the theme – explore the phrase ‘caring for others’.

- Discuss what the phrase ‘caring for others’ means. What does the word ‘care’ mean? Explore related words (careful, carefully, childcare, carer).
- Can pupils give examples of times they have cared for others? Or texts that they have read that include the theme?

Comparing the texts – explore the theme of caring for others

Discuss the questions below, exploring the theme of caring for others with the pupils.

**Q** What do *The Lady with the Lollipop*, *Khalsa Aid: How Sikhs care for others* and *Diary of a Paramedic* all have in common?

**Q** Which text taught you the most about caring for others? Why was this?

**Q** Which was your favourite text in the collection? What was it that made it so enjoyable?

Ask pupils to discuss their favourite text, finding someone with a different favourite and discuss their choices.

**Q** Does this change how you think about your favourite text?
