

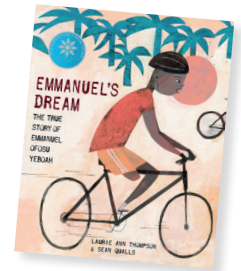
Whole Book Class Reading Suggestions

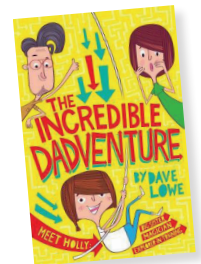
